ABSTRACT

The CBMS is an organized process of data collection and processing at the local level and of integration of data in local planning, program implementation and impact monitoring. It is a system that promotes evidence-based policymaking and program implementation while empowering communities to participate in the process. This system aims to provide policy-makers, investors, researchers and all stakeholders with updated socio-economic data on the welfare conditions of all members of the community in 66 barangays of the city. This project will facilitate the documentation of complete and updated socio-economic profiles of the 66 barangays and updating of the City Socio-Economic Profile, actual enumeration and Geo-Tagging of all household and barangay facilities/institutional structures will be done. Further the project results would serve as cost effective basis for the City's development planning (CLUP, CDP, AIP, DRRMP and other local plans) impact monitoring and evaluation of implemented projects, programs and services and in tracking the Millennium Development Goals (MDG) at the local level.
