### Guidelines of Submission

Submit abstract of oral or poster presentations with the following format:

- Theme and research topic before the title
- Title/Author(s) name with Affiliation, Email address and other contact details
- Key points of the manuscript not to exceed 250 words and 5 to 6 keywords

Upon acceptance, authors will be required to submit an Extended Abstract, not exceeding 5 pages (written on A4 paper size, single space, Times New Roman 12 font size), excluding the references.

- Submission of extended abstract is prerequisite for Oral and Poster Presentations

Registration is FREE for oral (paper) and poster presenters.

Cash and in-kind prizes shall be awarded to the winners of best papers and best posters (professional and student category)
